President of the Association for Diabetes, Obesity, and Cardiometabolic Diseases of the Republic of Srpska.

As author or co-author, she has published 21 publications, including 9 scientific monographs and textbooks, 4 conference proceedings, and 8 clinical guidelines, as well as over 300 original scientific papers. She has actively participated in 350 international congresses and scientific symposia, many of which she attended as an invited lecturer and as a member of scientific and organizational committees.

She has served as coordinator of 18 scientific research projects and 7 clinical studies as the principal investigator. In 2022, she was elected as a Corresponding Member of the Academy of Sciences and Arts of the Republic of Srpska (ANURS) in the working membership category. She is the recipient of several awards and recognitions, among which the following stand out:
