Nemanja Jovicic was born in 1999 in East Sarajevo (Bosnia and Herzegovina). He began his academic education at the Faculty of Health Studies, University of Sarajevo, where he earned a bachelor's degree in Medical Laboratory Diagnostics. He completed his master's studies at the same faculty, obtaining the title of Master of Laboratory Technologies. During his studies, he was actively involved in academic life as the president of the student organization and a member of the Senate of the University of Sarajevo.
